P. Tzortzakis studied Business Administration at the University of Piraeus and earned a Master's degree in Computer Science from Brooklyn College in New York (USA). He is the founder of Forthnet S.A., the largest alternative fixed-line telephony and subscription TV provider in Greece, which was listed on the Athens Stock Exchange and acquired NOVA in 2017. He served as the company's CEO from its founding in 1995 until 2010, and also as Chairman and CEO of the satellite subscription TV platform NOVA after its acquisition by Forthnet. He was a member of the Supervisory Board of NETIA SA and served as Chairman of the Board of Directors of SEPE (Federation of Hellenic Information Technology & Communications Enterprises). In 2012, he served as Deputy Minister of E-Governance at the Ministry of Administrative Reform and E-Governance. P. Tzortzakis was also the CEO of Quest Holdings S.A., Chairman of its subsidiaries, Executive Vice President and member of the Board of Directors of the Quest Group, as well as a member of the Board of Directors of the Athens Stock Exchange (ATHEX). In 2023, he was unanimously elected as an external member of the Governing Council of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens (NKUA), and he is a non-executive member of the Board of Directors of the Board of Directors of the Hellenic Development Bank.
